

SCHOOL'S OUT!

A Group Exhibition in New York City
Summer 2011



The New York Professional Outreach Program (NYPOP), in collaboration with the Caelum Gallery, will be hosting a juried exhibition for student artists and recent graduates.

Twelve artists will be selected for participation in a group show at the Caelum Gallery in the Summer of 2011.

ELIGIBILITY

Application is open to all current fine art students and graduates of any US college or university, from the years 2006 - 2011.

Video and sound work will not be considered.

EXHIBITION DETAILS

The exhibition will be held at Caelum Gallery in Chelsea from May 31 to June 11, 2011.

A reception will be held on May 31 from 6:00 - 8:00 pm.

50% of all sales will go to the artist, with 25% to NYPOP and 25% to the Caelum Gallery.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Art that is hung on the wall must not exceed 3 feet in width. Gallery pedestals can hold sculpture of a maximum 17 x 23 inches at the base. Sculpture on the floor must not exceed 4 feet in height and 3 feet in any other dimension.

Submit up to 5 images in Jpeg format (300dpi, not to exceed 2MB). Do not send original work. Include SASE if you want your materials returned.

Submitted material should be clearly labeled with the artist's name and contact information, including email as well as title, medium, and dimensions of the work.

There is a \$25 entry and administration fee. Please send a check or money order, payable to Caelum Gallery. Do not send cash.

Deadline for submission is April 15, 2011. Applicants will be notified via email by May 8.

Accepted works must be received in the gallery between May 24-28. Artists are responsible for shipping costs to and from the gallery. Work may be hand delivered to the gallery Tuesday through Friday between the hours of 11am and 5pm.
